- > Graded C- or better
- Documented on an official transcript from an accredited institution of academic instruction
- > Test credits (such as AP, CLEP, IB) must be from a verified testing agency (such as College Board)

### **Fall Entry Applicants**

Application Deadline: February 15

Decision Notification: Beginning April 15

### **Studio-Based Majors**

Studio-based majors are fall entry only.

Applicants must submit completed applications including a portfolio and additional essay by **November 1**.
